

Chalet Suzanne and Bok Towers



Chalet Suzanne, Lake Wales, Florida has a proud heritage, going back to 1931, and is now listed on the National Register of Historic Places. On the property are five dining rooms, 30 guest rooms, a landing strip, a gift shop, spa, the ceramic studio, a cannery for soups and sauces, citrus groves and a small experimental vineyard.

One of the first leisure travel books, *Adventures in Good Eating*, published by Duncan Hines, always listed Chalet Suzanne prominently as a wonderful place to stay and dine on the way to and from Florida.

Soup production started over 50 years ago in the garage and over the years have been served in the Governors' mansions in all fifty states, at the World's Fair and aboard international flights. Best of all, though, Chalet Suzanne Soups were selected by NASA and the crew of Apollo 15 to be aboard their trip to the moon in 1973. Today you'll **visit the soup production facility.**



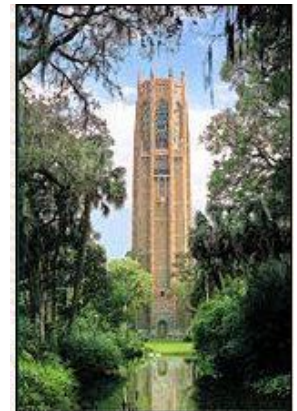
But the essence of the Chalet's reputation is its cuisine, food that Gourmet Magazine calls "glorious" ... served in a unique setting of five quaint rooms on many levels, overlooking the lake. Every corner glows with antiques, stained glass and old lamps from far away places. Dining at **Chalet Suzanne** is an experience. The elegant brunch includes delightful items from the bakery, the butcher and cheese maker, the garden and the patisserie as well as selections from the kitchen. You *will not* go away hungry!

From food heaven we wander a short distance to **Bok Tower Gardens**. This National Historic Landmark is an oasis of beauty and tranquility that was dedicated in 1929 as a gift to America from Edward W. Bok. Stroll the lush landscapes of the gardens, marvel at the majestic 205-foot-tall art deco and neo-Gothic marble and coquina rock Singing Tower that houses one of the world's finest carillons. Stop and sit awhile, and just listen ... feel the stress of today's busy world just float away.
