

# Savannah & Jekyll Island, GA

## October 21 to 24, 2008

**Day 1:** Depart from BSPC for a leisurely day of travel to Savannah. **Lunch** is included en-route along with regular comfort stops. Arriving late afternoon we check-in to the **Hilton Garden Inn Historic District**. The Hilton is adjacent to City Market which has numerous restaurants as well as art galleries, boutiques, candy and coffee shops. Dinner is on your own this evening. (L)

**Day 2:** After a **full breakfast buffet** your day will begin with a **narrated trolley tour of beautiful Historic Savannah**. We will tour one of Savannah's famous homes, the **Juliette Gordon Low Birthplace**, founder of the Girl Scouts of America before setting you free to explore on your own. Today is your opportunity to "experience" Savannah with your **all day trolley pass** with hop-on/hop off privileges throughout the historic district. Wander the "tabby" streets—made from a kind of primitive concrete mashed up with oyster shells, stroll through the beautiful oak-lined streets, rest your feet sitting on one of the many park benches in one or more of the twenty-two lovely "town squares" surrounding antebellum houses adorned with intricate iron balconies and intriguing details ... there is so much to see. (Various mansion tours are available; Admission is on your own and is usually \$6-\$8 per person/per mansion.)

Enjoy Savannah's waterfront area where you can shop, eat, stroll and people watch or watch the ships load their cargo from one of the busiest coastal ports. Experience the splendor and discover the secrets of the Old South. **Dinner** is included this evening. (B D)

**Day 3:** After **breakfast** we board the coach for a **sweet mystery stop** and then take a **river cruise** and enjoy a **southern-style lunch buffet catered by Lady & Sons**. Following our cruise we will board the coach and take in some local sights outside the historic district. **Dinner** is included this evening. (B L D)

**Day 4:** After **breakfast** we depart for a visit to **Jekyll Island**; a cluster of 19th Century mansions. We begin with a **narrated tram tour** through the "Historic District" and see how the nation's wealthiest citizens like J.P. Morgan and William Rockefeller lived and played. Hear the history of how the famous "club" was formed by some of America's most prominent families who at one time controlled 1/6th of the world's wealth. We will conclude our tour with **Lunch at the Jekyll Island Club Hotel**. An early afternoon departure will put us back in Punta Gorda approximately 9:30pm including comfort and food stop (on your own). Travel time may vary due to traffic conditions. (B L)
